Basketball 2020-21 Protocols

- All AHSAA "Best Practices" recommendations will be adhered to for home and visiting teams, fans, and spectators. <u>AHSAA Best Practices</u>.

 Social distancing and facial covering are required for <u>all attendees, including players on the bench and coaching staff.</u>
- Sanitizing stations will be available for all spectators and participants when entering facility.
- All attendees will be required to have a digital thermometer reading under 100.4
- Visiting coaches and players will be properly screened upon arrival at OAA facility.
- Mask must be worn at all times when not actively participating in the game.
- Coaches will monitor all players on their team throughout the event for social distancing and facial covering.
- Each team is responsible for their own team water.
- Gym & Locker Rooms will be cleaned prior and after games.
- Both sides of the bleachers will be used to socially distance between home and visiting spectators. When departing, visiting team supporters in stands will leave first, followed by the home team supporters in stands. The visiting team will leave first followed by the home team.
- Family members must sit together but maintain 6ft socially distance from others while wearing facial coverings.
- Seating areas will be clearly indicated along with socially distance signage.
- Parents will provide transportation for away games.
- OAA protocols must be observed at away games. OAA coaches will contact their opponents' coach to be made aware of the schools' protocols.

Basketball Attendance

- Elementary/Middle school teams are only allowed <u>two guests per player</u> to attend home games. No other spectators will be allowed entry into the facility unless you are deemed necessary staff.
- High School games will be allowed only 80 spectators (40 visitors & 40 home) not including teams, coaching staff, and necessary staff.
